2010 Norton	\$22/\$7
Celebrate the grape often touted as the "Cabernet of the East." Dry red. Estate grown.	
2011 Cabernet Sauvignon	\$24/\$7
America's most popular wine. Aged for 20 months in American and French oak barrels. Fruit from Washington State. Dry red.	
2013 Chambourcin **available Summer 2015**	\$22/\$7
Dry red. Estate grown. Originally a limited production Enoch trial grape, now going into full production.	
2012 Merlot	\$22/\$7
Terrific medium bodied wine. Smooth, soft and fruity with hints of cherry, plum & vanilla. Dry red.	
2012 Blanc DuBois Dry	\$15/\$6
Profile similar to Riesling. Light, fruity, spicy apple and pear. 0% residual sugar. Dry white. Estate grown.	
2013 Villard Blanc **available Spring 2015**	\$17/\$6
Similar to Chardonnay. Soft, buttery with hints of hazel nut and honeydew melon. Dry white. Estate grown.	

Sweet Wines

2012 Cweet Cynthiana	\$15/\$6
Full bodied rosé wine. Dark fruit flavors in a sweet Southern tradition. Red. Estate grown.	
2012 Sweet Lenoir	\$15/\$6
Medium bodied rosé wine. Reminiscent of Sangria. Red. Estate grown.	
2012 Susan's Secret	\$15/\$6
Light bodied blush wine. Similar to White Zinfandel. Red. Estate grown.	
2012 Blanc Du Bois Sweet	\$15/\$6
Profile similar to Riesling. Light and fruity. Spicy apple and pear. 5% residual sugar. White. Estate grown.	
2012 Blanc Du Bois Off-Dry	\$15/\$6
Profile similar to Riesling. Light and fruity. Spicy apple and pear. 2% residual sugar. White. Estate grown.	
2012 Potter's Hand	\$17/\$6
Sweet red wine. Texas grape, Champanel. Reminds you of the grape juice you had as a child. 11% alc. 11% sugar.	

Dessert Wines

2011 Ellen's Song	\$21/\$7
Dry red Port-style. Fashioned from the Lenoir grape. Complex, full bodied. 17.3% alcohol. 3% residual sugar.	
2012 Ellen's Sweet Song	\$21/\$7
Port-style red wine. Identical to Ellen's Song but much sweeter. 17.3% alcohol. 14% residual sugar.	
2012 Marla's Melody	\$21/\$7
Potent, sweet white dessert wine. Reminiscent of a rich orange liqueur. 18.2% alcohol. 11.0% residual sugar.	
2008 Enoch's Port Preview **on premise consumption only**	\$39/\$10
Rich, semi-sweet, red Port wine. Barrel aged for 4 years. 18% alcohol. Will be officially released SEPT 2014.
